

18. Board Policy Attendance Area Boundaries

The Board has established attendance area boundaries for schools within the Division, with consideration given to the following factors:

1. Educational opportunities available.
2. Age and grade level of students.
3. Distance and convenience by regularly traveled routes.
4. Natural boundaries such as rivers, lakes and man-made obstacles.

Bow Island Elementary School Attendance Area

Prairie Rose resident students from ECS to Grade 3 in the Bow Island Elementary attendance area will attend Bow Island Elementary School.

The Bow Island Elementary attendance area includes the area within the following boundary; from the NE corner of 36-13-13 east 13 miles to NE36-13-11; south 11 ½ miles to the South Saskatchewan River; east along the South Saskatchewan River to NE29-12-08; south 3 miles to the northern boundary of Rattlesnake Reservoir at NW09-12-08; east 2 miles to NE10-12-08; south 14 miles to SE03-10-08; west 1 mile to NE33-09-08; south 12 miles to SE04-08-08; west 19 miles to SW04-08-11; north 18 miles to NW33-10-11; west ½ mile to SW04-11-11; north 2 miles to the South Saskatchewan River at NE08-11-11; west and north following the South Saskatchewan River and Bow River to NE36-13-13.

Burdett School Attendance Area

Prairie Rose resident students from ECS to Grade 9 in the Burdett attendance area will attend the Burdett School.

The Burdett attendance area includes the area within the following boundary: from the NW corner of 07-11-12 east along the South Saskatchewan River to NE08-11-11; south 2 miles to SE05-11-11; east ½ mile to NW33-10-11; south 18 miles to SE05-08-11; west 8 miles to the County of Forty Mile / MD of Taber boundary; north following the common boundary between the County of Forty Mile / MD of Taber to NW07-11-12.

Eagle Butte High School Attendance Area

Prairie Rose resident students from Grade 10 to Grade 12 in the Eagle Butte attendance area will attend the Eagle Butte High School.

The Eagle Butte attendance area includes the area within the following boundary but excludes the City of Medicine Hat; from the NE corner of border at NE36-21-01; south along the Alberta / Saskatchewan border to the northern boundary of Township 3; west 24 miles to the Cypress County / County of Forty Mile boundary at NW31-03-04; north along the common boundary of Cypress County / County of Forty Mile to NE 12-06-05; west 17 miles to NW08-06-07; north 12 miles to NW08-08-07; west 4 miles to NW10-08-08; north 10 miles to NW34-09-08; east 1 mile to NW35-09-08; north 14 miles to the NE10-12-08; west 2 miles to NW09-12-08; north 2

miles to the South Saskatchewan River; west along the South Saskatchewan River to SE01-12-11; north 29 ½ miles to NW31-16-10; east 9 miles to NE33-16-09.

Foremost School Attendance Area

Prairie Rose resident students from ECS to Grade 12 in the Foremost attendance area will attend Foremost School.

The Foremost attendance area includes the area within the following boundary: from the NW corner of 31-07-12 east 27 miles along the boundary between Township 7 and 8 to SW03-08-08; north 2 miles to SW 15-08-08; east 4 miles to NE07-08-07; south 12 miles to SE18-06-07; east 17 miles to the boundary of Cypress County / County of Forty Mile at NE12-06-05; south 14 miles to SW06-04-04; east 24 miles to the Alberta / Saskatchewan border at NE36-03-01; south 18 miles along the Alberta / Saskatchewan border to the Canada / United States border; west 60 miles along the Canada / United States border to the boundary between County of Forty Mile and County of Warner at SW06-01-10; north and west along the County of Forty Mile / County of Warner boundary to NW31-07-12

Irvine School Attendance Area

Prairie Rose resident students from ECS to Grade 9 in the Irvine attendance area will attend Irvine School.

The Irvine attendance area includes the area within the following boundary: from the NE corner of 35-13-05 east 25 miles along the northern boundary of Township 13 to the Alberta / Saskatchewan border; south 60 miles along the Alberta / Saskatchewan border to the northern boundary of Township 3; west 24 miles to the boundary of Cypress County / County of Forty Mile at NW31-03-04; north following the common boundary of Cypress County / County of Forty Mile to SW28-08-05; north 22 miles to NW09-12-05; continuing north along the eastern limits of the City of Medicine Hat and the South Saskatchewan River to NE35-13-05.

Isabel F. Cox, Margaret Wooding and Parkside Schools Attendance Area (Redcliff Schools)

Prairie Rose resident students from ECS to Grade 9 in the Redcliff Schools attendance area will attend Isabel F. Cox (ECS to Grade 3), Margaret Wooding (Grade 4 to Grade 6) or Parkside School (Grade 7 to Grade 9).

The Redcliff Schools attendance area includes the area within the following boundary; from the NW corner of 36-14-08 east along the Canadian Forces Base boundary to the South Saskatchewan River; south and west following the South Saskatchewan River to the boundary of Cypress County and the City of Medicine Hat at NE25-13-06; west 2 ½ miles to W 27-13-06; south 4 ½ miles to the South Saskatchewan River; west along the South Saskatchewan River to SW06-13-08; north 1 ½ miles to NW07-13-08; east 9 miles to NE09-13-07; north 4 miles to NE33-13-07; west 4 miles to SW01-14-08; north 6 miles to NW36-14-08.

Jenner School Attendance Area

Prairie Rose resident students from Grade 1 to Grade 9 in the Jenner attendance area will attend Jenner School. Prairie Rose resident students from Grade 10 to 12 in the Jenner attendance area will attend Duchess School, except for students residing north of the Red Deer River who will attend South Central High School in Oyen.

The Jenner attendance area includes the area within the following boundary: from the NW corner of 21-23-08 east 10 miles to NE24-23-07; south 4 miles to SE01-23-07; east 12 miles to NE36-22-05; south 5 ¼ miles to the Red Deer River at NE01-22-05; west along the Red Deer River to NW06-22-05; south 10 miles to the boundary of Canadian Forces Base at SE24-20-06; west and south along the boundary of Canadian Forces Base to the northern boundary of Township 16 at NE33-16-09; west 9 miles to the Cypress County / County of Newell boundary at NW31-16-10; north along the common boundary of Cypress County / County of Newell to the Red Deer River at NW07-21-10; north and east along the Red Deer River to NE29-22-08; north 5 miles to NW21-23-08.

New Brigden School Attendance Area

Prairie Rose resident students from Grade 1 to Grade 5 in the New Brigden attendance area will attend the New Brigden School.

The New Brigden attendance area includes the area within the following boundary: from the N corner of 21-30-07 north 1.5 miles to center of 33-30-07; east 1 ½ miles to E 34-30-07; north ½ mile to NE 34-30-07; west ¾ mile to S 03-31-07; north 3 ½ miles to center of 22-31-07; east 1 mile to center of 23-31-07; north 2 miles to center of 35-31-07; east 3 miles to center of 32-31-06; north 1 ½ miles to N 05-32-06; east 1 mile to N 04-32-06; north 1 mile to N 09-32-06; east 5 ½ miles to SE 17-31-05; North 2 miles to SW 29-30-05; east 28 miles following the Prairie Rose / Prairie Land boundary to the Alberta/Saskatchewan border, south 12 miles following the Alberta / Saskatchewan border to SE 25-30-1; west 29 miles to the N corner of 21-30-07.

Oyen Public School Attendance Area

Prairie Rose resident students from Grade 1 to Grade 9 in the Oyen Public attendance area will attend the Oyen Public School.

The Oyen Public attendance area includes the area within the following boundary: from the N corner of 21-30-07; east 29 miles to the Alberta / Saskatchewan border at NE24-30-01; south 20 miles following the Alberta / Saskatchewan border to SE13-27-01; west 6 miles to SW18-27-01; south 2 miles to SW06-27-01; west 12 miles to NE36-26-04; south 22 miles to the Red Deer River at SE13-23-04; west following the Red Deer River to NW06-22-04; north 5 ¼ miles to NE 36-22-05; west 12 ½ miles to SE 01-23-07; north 4 miles to NE 24-23-07; west 10 miles to the Prairie Rose / Prairie Land boundary at NE 20-23-08; north 31 ½ miles to E 32-28-08; east 2 miles to E 34-28-08; north 3 ½ miles to NE 15-29-08; east 1 mile to NE 14-29-08; north ½ mile to E 23-29-08; east 1 mile to E24-29-08; north 1 mile to E 25-29-08; east 1 mile to E 30-29-07; north 1 ½ miles to NE 31-29-07; east 4 miles to SE 02-30-07; north 1 mile to NE 02-30-07; east

1 mile to NE 01-30-07; north 2 miles to NE 13-30-07; west 3 ½ miles to N 16-30-07; north 1 mile to the N corner of 21-30-7

The Oyen Public attendance area also includes the New Brigden attendance area for grades 6 – 9 students.

Ralston School Attendance Area

Prairie Rose resident students from ECS to Grade 9 in the Ralston attendance area will attend Ralston School.

The Ralston attendance area includes the area within the following boundary; from the NW corner of 31-16-10 east 9 miles along the north boundary of Township 16 to the boundary of Canadian Forces Base; south and east along the Canadian Forces Base Boundary to NE35-14-08; south 6 miles to SE02-14-08; east 4 miles to NE33-13-07; south 4 miles to SE16-13-07; west 9 miles to SW18-13-08; south 1 ½ miles to the South Saskatchewan River; west following the South Saskatchewan River to W01-12-11; north 29 ½ miles to NW31-16-10.

Schuler School Attendance Area

Prairie Rose resident students from Kindergarten to Grade 9 in the Schuler attendance area will attend Schuler School.

The Schuler attendance area includes the area within the following boundary: from the NE corner of 36-21-01 south 48 miles along the Alberta / Saskatchewan border to NE36-13-01; west 25 miles along the northern boundary of Township 13 to the South Saskatchewan River at NE35-13-05; north following the South Saskatchewan River to NE35-16-05; east 5 ½ miles along the Canadian Forces Base boundary to NE34-16-04; north and east following the South Saskatchewan River to the Alberta / Saskatchewan border at NE36-21-01.

Senator Gershaw School Attendance Area

Prairie Rose resident students from Grade 4 to Grade 6 in the Senator Gershaw elementary attendance area will attend Senator Gershaw School.

The Senator Gershaw elementary attendance area includes the area within the following boundary; from the NE corner of 36-13-13 east 13 miles to NE36-13-11; south 11 ½ miles to the South Saskatchewan River; east along the South Saskatchewan River to NE 29-12-08; south 3 miles to the northern boundary of Rattlesnake Reservoir at NW09-12-08; east 2 miles to NE10-12-08; south 14 miles to SE03-10-08; west 1 mile to NE33-09-08; south 12 miles to SE04-08-08; west 19 miles to SW04-08-11; north 18 miles to NW33-10-11; west ½ mile to SW04-11-11; north 2 miles to the South Saskatchewan River at NE08-11-11; west and north along the South Saskatchewan River to NE36-13-13.

Prairie Rose resident students from Grade 7 to Grade 12 in the Senator Gershaw junior/senior high attendance area will attend Senator Gershaw School.

The Senator Gershaw junior / senior high attendance area includes the area within the following boundary; from the NE corner of 36-13-13 east 13 miles to NE 36-13-11; south 11 ½ miles to the South Saskatchewan River; east along the South Saskatchewan River to NE29-12-08; south 3 miles to the northern boundary of Rattlesnake Reservoir at NW09-12-08; east 2 miles to NE10-12-08; south 14 miles to SE 03-10-08; west 1 mile to SE04-10-08; south 12 miles to SE04-08-08; west along the boundary between Township 7 and 8 to the boundary of the County of Forty Mile and the MD of Taber; north following the common boundary between the County of Forty Mile and the MD of Taber to the South Saskatchewan River at NW 07-11-12; west and north along the South Saskatchewan River to NE36-13-13.

Seven Persons School Attendance Area

All Prairie Rose resident students from ECS to Grade 9 in the Seven Persons attendance area will attend the Seven Persons School.

The Seven Persons attendance area includes the area within the following boundary; from the NW corner of 28-12-08 east along the South Saskatchewan River to SE06-13-06; south and east along the western boundary of the City of Medicine Hat to NE21-12-06; south 1 ½ miles to E16-12-06; east ½ mile to the middle of 15-12-06; south ½ mile to S15-12-06; east ½ mile to NE10-12-06; south 1 mile to NE03-12-06; east 4 miles to NE05-12-05; south 21 miles to the common boundary of Cypress County / County of Forty Mile; south and east following the common boundary of Cypress County / County of Forty Mile to SE13-06-05; west 17 miles to SW17-06-07; north 12 miles to NE07-08-07; west 4 miles to SW15-08-08; north 10 miles to NW34-09-08; east 1 mile to NE34-09-08; north 14 miles to NE 10-12-08; west 2 miles to NW09- 12-08; north 3 miles to the South Saskatchewan River at NW28-12-08.

South Central High School Attendance Area

Prairie Rose resident students from Grade 10 to Grade 12 in the South Central attendance area will attend South Central High School.

The South Central attendance area includes the area within the following boundary: from the NE corner of 20-32-05 east 28 miles to the Alberta / Saskatchewan border; south 64 miles along the Alberta / Saskatchewan border to the South Saskatchewan River at SE01-22-01; south and west along the South Saskatchewan River to the Canadian Forces Base boundary at SW19-19- 02; north 6 miles following the Canadian Forces Base boundary to NE13-20-03; west 18 miles along the Canadian Forces Base boundary to SE24-20-06; north 10 miles to the Red Deer River; west along the Red Deer River to the common Prairie Rose / Prairie Land boundary at SW33-22-08; north 36 ½ miles following the Prairie Rose / Prairie Land boundary to E 32-28-08; east 2 miles to E 34-28-08; north 3 ½ miles to NE 15-29-08; east 1 mile to NE14-29-08; north ½ mile to E 23-29-08; east 1 mile to E 24-29-08; north 1 mile to E 25-29-08; east 1 mile to E 30- 29-07; north 1 ½ miles to NE31-29-07; east 4 miles to SE 02-30-07; north 1 mile to NE02-30-07; east 1 mile to NE01-30-07; north 2 miles to NE 13-30-07; west 3 ½ miles to N 16-30-07; north 2 ½ miles to center of 33-30-07; east 1 ½ miles to E 34-30-07; north ½ mile to NE 34-30-07; west ¾ mile to S 03-31-07; north 3 ½ miles to center of 22-31-07; east 1

Warren Peers School Attendance Area

Prairie Rose resident students from Grade 1 to Grade 9 in the Warren Peers attendance area will attend Warren Peers School.

The Warren Peers attendance area includes the area within the following boundary: from the NW corner of 31-26-03 east 12 miles to NE36-26-02; north 2 miles to NW07-27-01; east 6 miles to the Alberta / Saskatchewan border; south 32 miles along the Alberta / Saskatchewan border to SE01-22-01; south and west along the South Saskatchewan River to the Canadian Forces Base boundary at SW19-19-02; north and west along the Canadian Forces Base boundary to the line between ranges 5 and 6 at SW19-20-05; north 10 miles to the Red Deer River at SW07- 22-05; east along the Red Deer River to SE13-23-04; north 22 miles to NW31-26-03.
